CPTED on April 10th - Did You Miss It?

John Lusher gave a very thorough explanation of Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) complete with examples in the style of "Bad Idea/Good Idea." CPTED's objectives are: to reduce crime, to reduce fear of crime, to improve sense of order, to improve sense of pride, and to improve sociability. CPTED professionals use the 3 D's – Definition, Designation, & Design – when applying the basic principles of natural surveillance, access management, territoriality, facility management, order management (or showing care), and activity support. Remember that minor trespasses and vandalism can lead to major crimes if not tended to and that facilities can be held accountable for failure to prevent such activities ([see file](#)).

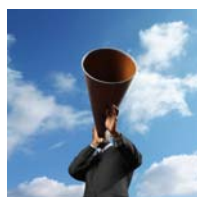
