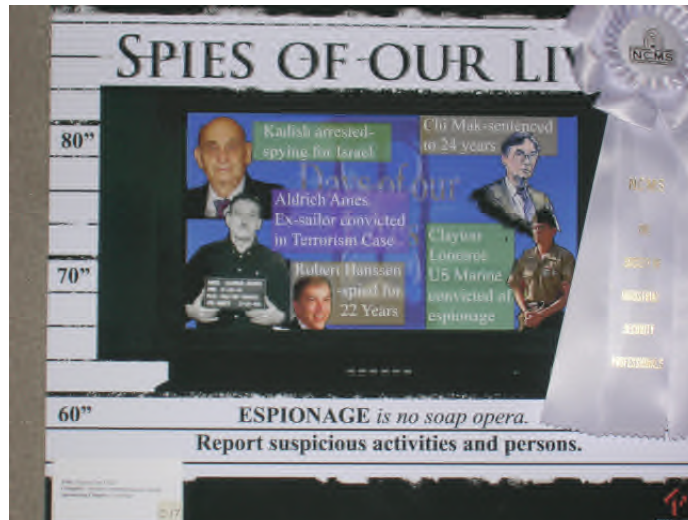

Who is Joshua Builta?

Joshua Builta is currently assigned to the Texas Fusion Center as an Intelligence Officer within the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Office of Intelligence & Analysis (I&A). In this role, Mr. Builta helps guide and strengthen information sharing between DHS and state and local partners within Texas, thus enhancing overall intelligence capabilities and homeland security efforts. On a daily basis Mr. Builta provides direct support to the Texas Fusion Center staff while providing DHS leadership with real-time situational awareness on events of a national interest.

He will be discussing his role and position in Austin, how he can assist ASIS members, and giving a brief unclassified threat brief.
