

Senior Trade Compliance Manager – Salary Range: \$79,540 to \$99,419

Purpose:

The purpose of this position is to establish, supervise, and administer Aviall's policies and procedures regarding import and export compliance and the shipment of goods, including the transport of dangerous goods. Specific efforts will include Import/Export licensing, Aviall International Trade/Blacklist Compliance Program, International Trade Compliance, FCPA and anti-boycott compliance. The Trade Compliance Manager will provide day-to-day supervision of department personnel, develop company policy and procedures and act as the liaison between the Trade Compliance Department and Aviall's business units including their respective managers and directors and liaison with the Boeing Office of Internal Governance/Global Trade Compliance.

Decision Making Authority of this Position:

The Senior Trade Compliance Manager shall be given decision-making authority with regards to trade compliance related activities. Manager will provide recommendations, expertise, and knowledge necessary for the development, implementation, and management of Aviall's Trade Compliance Programs to ensure compliance with domestic and foreign government import and export regulations, anti-corruption regulations, and regulations regarding the shipment of goods. Manager will be designated as the Empowered official, or supervise the Empowered Official, who will conduct business and make decisions in regards to export license applications, approvals and denials involving the U.S. Dept of State, U.S. Dept of Commerce, U.S. Customs, U.S. Dept. of Treasury Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC). Manager shall also have the authority to ensure that Aviall is in full compliance with the regulations of Bureau of Census, Department of Homeland Security/Office of Foreign Assets Control, Bureau of Customs and Border Protection Department of Transportation, and, as appropriate, the World Customs Organization and foreign regulatory agencies governing import, exports, and the transportation of goods within a foreign country. Manager will also have authority to sign other trade compliance documentation required by US and foreign governmental authorities.

Required Education and Experience:

- Bachelor Degree in Business Administration, International
- Studies, Public Administration or related field of study.
- 10+ years experience in international compliance regulations (EAR/IT AR).
- Experience as a designated Empowered Official.

- Texas House Bill 218 (Voter ID Bill) was filibustered and this is what caused the death of SB 1164, and other bills funding vital state agencies like the Texas Department of Transportation.
- Texas Senate Bill 1164 (Concealed Carry on Campus Bill) died at the stroke of midnight, May 24th due to the House Calendars Committee failing to schedule it for a vote by the full Texas House of Representatives.
